- Build a more user-friendly community. Be sure local buildings and public property are wheelchair accessible. Is there a warm water accessible swimming pool in your town? Do your fitness centers have accessible workout equipment like a NuStep?
- As you administer the vaccine worldwide, connect with PHI on polio support organizations, such as hospitals or networking groups in developing nations. PHI can help them.
- Assist local polio survivors in need with purchase of "disability necessities" such as split-size shoes, stair lifts, scooters, braces, vans, bath lifts, wheelchairs, crutches, home modifications (such as ramps), also in-home personal and/or household help.
